## MIKE PRESSLER CAMP DIRECTOR

Head Lacrosse Coach at Bryant University ... Head Coach Team USA 2010 Assistant Coach 2002 Gold Medal Team USA ... Coached 83 All-Americans ... 42 North-South All-Stars ... Coach of the South All-Star Team 1993 ... USILA National Division I Coach of The Year 2005 ... NCAA Coach of the Year 1987 Div III ... ACC Champions 1995, 2001, 2002 ... NCAA Final Four 1997, 2005 ... Ranked as high as 2nd nationally ... 15 year Record at Duke 148-77...100 % graduation rate ... In his first year as head coach of Bryant University, Pressler guided the Bulldogs to their first ever Northeast10 Conference regular season title and a top seed in the conference tournament playoffs. During the 2007 season, Bryant tied a school record with 10 consecutive wins including an undefeated 9-0 mark in the Northeast 10. Among those wins was an overtime victory against defending national champion Le Moyne, snapping the Dolphin's 70-game win streak. The Bulldogs, ranked as high as No. 4 nationally in 2008, gained the No. 1 regional ranking for the entire month of April... In 2008 won their second conference title, defeating top-ranked Le Moyne in Syracuse, NY in May. The win earned the Bulldogs their first-ever NCAA championship berth... In just his third season in Smithfield, R.I., Pressler led the Bulldogs into the Division I ranks and into a degree of success that shocked the DI lacrosse world. The 2009 Bulldogs faced off against such national powerhouses as Maryland, Virginia, Brown, Army, Penn and Loyola (Md.), earning a 10-5 overall record and recognition in both national polls throughout their inaugural campaign. Pressler's Bulldogs earned key wins over opponents such as Penn (15-11), Lehigh (14-13), Bellarmine (14-4) and Dartmouth (12-9), en route to becoming the biggest upset story of the season Record at Bryant University 35-13

## KAREN HEALY Girl's Camp Director

Named head coach of the Bryant University women's lacrosse team in July, 2008, Healy returns to Bryant where she coached the women's lacrosse team for three seasons, from 2005-07. During her coaching career at Bryant, she led the Bulldogs to a 32-16 overall record including a 23-7 record in the Northeast-10 Conference. She left Bryant following the 2007 season to become the head coach at Wagner College in 2008...A native of Freeport, New York where she was a high school All-American, Healy later enjoyed an outstanding career at Syracuse University. She helped lead the Orange to three NCAA championship appearances while earning two All-American honors...Healy arrived at Bryant in the spring of 2005 after serving as the Assistant Program Director at MetroLacrosse, Inc., a Boston-based organization that provides free lacrosse for the youth in Boston's historically underserved communities.

## CAMP STAFF

Mike Pressler's staff will include prestigious Division I, II and III head coaches, former and current players. Each camper will also have the opportunity to receive personalized instruction, before and after each session, from what promises to be a very talented 2009 staff.
